Efi Kanner is Associate Professor of Turkish Culture and Society in the Department of Turkish Studies and Modern Asian Studies of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. She graduated from the History and Archaeology Department of the same University. She was awarded a *Diplôme d'Études Approfondies (D.E.A.)* by the École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales (Paris) and a PhD from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. Her research interests cover fields of social history of the Late Ottoman Empire and Turkey including microhistory, the history of education and philanthropy, the history of gender relations, and the history of social movements in a cross-cultural perspective. Her previous research related to various aspects of *embourgeoisement*, mainly among Orthodox and Muslim populations in the late Ottoman period and Early Turkish Republic. Her last research concerns the movement against gender-based violence in Turkey and its political dimensions as well as the multiple gender aspects of Turkish modernization.
