Konstantinos Gogos, is an Assistant Professor (with tenure) at the Department of Turkish Studies and Modern Asian Studies, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. He teaches courses on political Islam in Turkey, Muslims in Europe, Geopolitics of Turkey and the Middle East, and Turkish-Greek translation. In the Department's postgraduate program he offers seminars related to Turkish Islamist thought, and the Geopolitics of Turkish political Islam in Europe. His research interests focus on Turkish Islamist intellectuals, History and Geopolitics of Turkey, Muslims and Islam in Europe.
